

You can make paper sculptures for interior decoration!

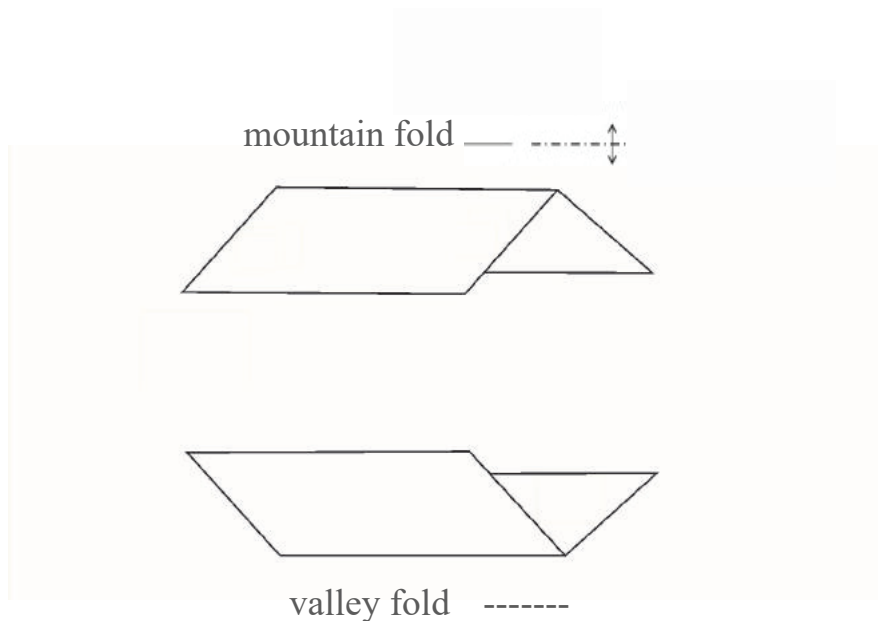
Printed digital template contains 19 pages and 4 pages of instructions (difficulty: easy).

To obtain the final result you must do the following simple steps:

1. Print the template on thick paper. To do this, you should purchase coloured paper with a density of 160-240 g/m². Print format (A4). If you need a different size, just change the print scale and paper size (A5 to A1).
2. Cut out details along the contour solid lines. Use a utility knife and a metal ruler.
3. Selling all dashed and dash-dotted lines blunt knife under a ruler. This will allow to smooth and sharp bends.
4. Bend parts in broken lines.

IMPORTANT: Bends are marked with a dash-dotted line, must be convex (in itself), and the designated bar - concave (away from you). This is an important condition for obtaining the correct geometry of the model. Be careful!
